HIGHLIGHTS MAR 2023 – OCT 2024

Our five founding members conducted their very first board meeting in March 2023, creating a non-profit organization and embarking on a mission to realize every youth's potential by engaging and empowering families and communities to advocate for all kids!

How are we achieving this?

In keeping with our goal of community engagement, we set up booths and initiated connections at several key local events, building awareness and forming partnerships within Diamond Valley:

Raise \$'s!

Our commitment to fundraising has allowed us to support and enhance educational and developmental opportunities for youth. Notable fundraising events include:

- Diamond Valley Napa Autopro Grand Opening and Charity Dunk Summer 2023
 Raised \$600 during a community dunking event, creating a memorable afternoon for all involved.
- Fraction Energy Charity Event Sept 2023
 With sponsorship from 17 oil and gas companies, we raised over \$35,000, establishing essential funding that set DVYF up for sustainable growth.
- Fall Fling Party for a Cause Nov 2023
 Our first large-scale fundraiser, which raised \$20,000. This event was instrumental in supporting Diamond Valley elementary schools with much-needed resources.
- Tim Hortons Holiday Smile Cookie Campaign Dec 2023
 Raised over \$1,800 from holiday cookie sales, with 50% of proceeds going directly to DVYF programs.
- Tim Hortons Smile Cookie Campaign May 2024
 Raised \$6,158 during the spring campaign, fully supporting the DVYF STEAM program for local youth.

This year, DVYF successfully applied for and received grants to continue essential programs:

- TC Energy Grant Summer 2024 \$7,500 for STEAM initiatives
- Friends of Sheep River Library Summer 2024 \$1,500 supporting STEAM programming
- Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) Grant Spring 2024 funding a community focused podcast initiative

Empower & Impact!

Through DVYF funding, we have supported various impactful initiatives that foster growth, community connection, and access to enriching experiences for youth:

- Fantastic Books and Where to Find Them! Jan 2024 to Jan 2025
 - A year-long, monthly book club for grades 7-12, fostering literacy and creating a safe space for youth to connect and explore books. Our sponsorship of \$2,000 ensured that participants receive a free book monthly and access to recreational activities.
- C. Ian Maclaren Donation Nov 2023
 - With a \$10,000 donation, DVYF provided stage lighting for school performances, enhancing arts education and community events.
- Turner Valley Elementary School Support Nov 2023
 - Donation of \$10,000 to support school-wide initiatives, enriching student learning experiences.
- Breakfast with Santa Dec 2023
 - Our \$1,000 donation supported this cherished holiday tradition at the Turner Valley Legion, benefiting 100 local children and their families.
- Family Support Dec 2023
 - In partnership with community donors, DVYF provided \$1,000 in financial support to a local family facing medical challenges, helping alleviate costs for essential needs.
- **Drillers Basketball Support** March 2024
 - Our \$1,000 donation covered costs for the Oilfields High School basketball team to attend the provincial championships, ensuring all families could cheer on the team.
- CIM Music Program Support March 2024
 - With \$1,500, DVYF covered travel expenses for 63 music students to attend the Alberta Provincial Music Festival, providing them with a valuable performance experience.
- Handball Tournament Sponsorship May 2024
 - Supported event costs for 250 local students at the Tier II Handball Provincials, promoting physical activity and community spirit.
- Foothills Skating Club Ice Carnival March 2024
 - DVYF's \$750 funding enabled costume updates for the Ice Carnival, showcasing young skaters' skills and dedication.
- Indigenous Cultural Luncheon June 2024
 - Through a \$1,000 sponsorship, DVYF contributed to an immersive event celebrating Indigenous traditions, enhancing cultural awareness for students and members of the indigenous community.
- Sprouts Summer Camp July-August 2024
 - Partnered with local organizations, providing \$1,300 to support summer day camps focused on nature, arts, and local community engagement.

- STEAM After School Club Starting September 2024
 DVYF subsidized 50% of enrollment costs, making this hands-on STEAM program
 accessible to 26 students. Held in collaboration with Sheep River Library, it fosters skills
 and interest in science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics.
- High Country Regional Band Program Support School Year 2024/25
 DVYF contributed \$2,500 toward band program activities, helping provide resources for a music clinic, band camp, and performances, supporting youth artistic development across multiple schools.

By remaining true to our vision, DVYF has created meaningful change and strengthened community bonds across Diamond Valley. We look forward to continued growth, partnerships, and expanding our reach to empower more youth and families in the years ahead.
