Funding Proposal Guidelines for the Diamond Valley Youth Foundation

These guidelines will help you prepare a clear and concise proposal for funding initiatives that support youth in the Diamond Valley region. Please ensure your proposal addresses each of the sections below.

1. Project Overview

Provide a brief description of your initiative, including:

- Project Title: Name of the initiative.
- Summary: A 2-3 sentence overview of the project's purpose and objectives.
- Target Audience: Specify the age group and demographic of the youth who will benefit.
- Goals: Outline the key goals of the initiative and expected impact.
- Timeline: Include start and end dates and any major milestones.

2. Budget

Present a clear overview of the financial requirements:

- Total Budget: The overall cost of the initiative.
- Funding Request: Specify the amount you are seeking from the foundation.
- Budget Breakdown: Briefly explain how the requested funds will be used (e.g., materials, personnel, marketing).

3. Youth Impact

Explain how the initiative will benefit youth:

• **Impact Statement**: Describe how the initiative will positively influence youth (e.g., skills, opportunities, well-being).

- Target Reach: Estimate the number of youths who will benefit from the initiative.
- Community Relevance: Show how the project addresses local youth needs or ties into the community.

5. Outcomes & Evaluation

Detail how success will be measured:

• Expected Outcomes: List the key results you hope to achieve.

• Evaluation Plan: Briefly describe how you will track progress and measure the initiative's impact (e.g., feedback, data collection).

- Length: 2-3 pages.
